We are now ready to welcome nominations for Erasmus exchange students for the 2014/15 academic year.

As you know, we now require evidence of all applicants' English language ability in the form of IELTS, TOEFL iBT, Pearson Academic PTE or one of the acceptable qualifications on the attached document, unless they are a native speaker of English. I regret we cannot consider any other type of English language qualification. DEADLINES

Nominations

Partners must nominate students wishing to study for the autumn semester or the full academic year 2014/15 by 30th April 2014..

Please note that nominations for students wishing to study in the departments of Business, English, Architecture and Culture/Film/Media (Communications Studies) in the spring semester 2014 must also be received by 30th April 2014.

For students wishing to study in all other departments in the spring semester 2014/15 nominations must be received by 30th September 2014..

When we have received the nominations and supporting documents, we will contact eligible students at the beginning of May 2014 and invite them to make an online application.

Online Applications

The deadline for students wishing to study for the autumn semester or the full academic year 2014/15 or for any students wishing to study in the departments of Business, English, Architecture

and Culture/Film/Media (Communications Studies) in either the autumn or spring semester is 31st May 2014.

Our online application deadline for other students wishing to study for the spring semester 2014/15 is 31st October 2014..

Paperwork for Erasmus students

Please note that the University is unable to sign learning agreements prior to students registering with the University at the start of their study period so please do not send any documentation to the International Office except those required for nomination as it will not be retained by the office.
