




BCU/Resa Housing accompanies the students, teachers and researchers interested in visiting flats and rooms.


Protocol:

- ⇒ We contact them to know their accommodation needs.
- ⇒ We send them different accommodation options (+ pictures, location maps, conditions, means of public transport) to allow them choose the one they prefer.
- ⇒ If they come with their children, we inform them about private schools or we help them to look for a public or semi-private school.
- ⇒ We attend their needs, giving them the same treatment given to expatriates of multinational companies.



Global data of the accommodation service

- ⇒ We accommodate directly more than 2,000 people every year of 75 different nationalities.
- ⇒ We inform more than 5,000 people.
- ⇒ Our website (<u>www.bcu.cat</u>) is visited by an average of 50,000 people.






Studying in Barcelona






- ⇒ Informative talks by the Mossos d'Esquadra (Police) to prevent and avoid crime.

Research in Barcelona

- Catalonia commitment to knowledge revolution1:
 - ⇒ 12 internationally recognised universities.
 - ⇒ 31% of the Catalan population aged 25-34 has university studies, % above the OECD average.
 - ⇒ 40% PhD students are foreigners.
 - ⇒ The new call for the Serra Húnter teacher recruitment program in Catalan universities has received 748 applications from 38 countries.
 - ⇒ 68 research centers that develop a high level scientific activity.
 - ⇒ 10 times more global scientific production comparing to the weight of the population. With 0.1% of the world population, Catalonia represents 1% of the international scientific production.
 - ⇒ 60% of the Catalan scientific production takes place in universities.

Research in Barcelona

- ⇒ ICREA researchers obtain 50% of the concessions of the European Research Council in Catalonia.
- ⇒ 62% of ICREA researchers who work in Catalonia come from abroad, most of them from USA and Great Britain.
- ⇒ 9 projects of researchers from the Catalan research system have been recognized with a Proof of Concept, to promote knowledge transfer.
- ⇒ 20 institutions in the world submit 11 proposals to the Barcelona KEY, future city of the economy knowledge.
- ⇒ 14 research entities involved in two major research projects of the European Commission of the FET-Flagship call, that will mobilize 2,000 million euros.


