Rules & Regulations

- ✓ If the student refuses the room assigned upon arrival, the deposit and 1st rent payment will not be refunded.
- ✓ If the student doesn't leave the room as it was found, the deposit cannot be reclaimed.

Check-in / Check out with the CROUS

✓ Building charges can be reclaimed after the stay as they are calculated each December.

Description of the accommodation (1)

- ✓ Individual room: 15m² to 25m²
- ✓ Studio or apartment of 2 bedrooms (kitchen & bathroom shared)
- ✓ Laundry
- ✓ Furniture included: bed, chair, desk, closet, fridge, electric cooker, "pots & pans"
- ✓ Not included: tableware, bed linen, internet, phone, electricity fees (2)

Rent per residence

300 € - 400 €/month, depending on the room and the residence (3)(4)

Additional information:

- ✓ Student is required to pay a rent insurance (40 € to 80 €). Generally this insurance also includes the civil responsibility insurance, required to obtain the UPEM student card.
- ✓ Student needs to open a bank account in order to pay their electricity bill and eventually receive the CAF.
- ✓ Opening a bank account is free. You must present your ID/Passport and justify an address in France. Some of French banks offer a free rent insurance with the account.
- ✓ The CAF application is given by the CROUS. More information on the website.

Fees to book a room

Payment only by bank transfer before the 24th of August. All information will be provided after having received the accommodation form.

 Only CROUS manages repartition of the rooms.
