Requirements:

Basic knowledge of the German language is strongly recommended as lectures are usually held in German. At least we expect a profound knowledge of English from the students and it is strongly recommended to attend a German course during the exchange in Linz.

In the following table you will find an estimate of the monthly living costs for students. The figures only serve as a guideline. Accommodation costs are based on a place in a student hall of residence.

Living Costs	
Accommodation costs (including heating and electricity)	€ 310
Food (excluding luxuries and tobacco)	€ 220
Study and personal requirements, books, culture, recreation	€ 270
