Coming to Austria / Please remember

- before travelling to Austria the regulations of the law relating to aliens regarding visas and residence titles
- after arrival in Austria the regulations concerning registration at your place of residence

Nationals of Third Countries

If you do not have EU/EEA or Swiss nationality you are a so-called "national of a third country" and you will need an entry and residence title for entry to and residence in Austria. Select the information according to the duration and purpose of your stay:

<u>Visiting lecturers, scientists, researchers</u>

If you are a national of an EU/EEA country or Switzerland you **need no visa and enjoy freedom of domicile** (Niederlassungsfreiheit). If you have sufficient financial means to finance your stay in Austria and a valid health insurance covering all the necessary costs you only need a valid travel document (passport or identity card) for entry to and residence in Austria.

You have to carry your travel document at all times as proof that you are entitled to stay in Austria or keep it in a place near you. If you want to make Austria your permanent residence, you can, if you wish, also apply for an "identification card for E.E.A. citizens" ("Lichtbildausweis für EWR-Bürger"). The issuing of this card costs EUR 56.

If you are going to stay in Austria for **more than 3 months** you have to register with the competent municipal authority (Magistrat, Bezirkshauptmannschaft) within 4 months of your stay and you will receive a **confirmation of registration** (fee: EUR 15; additional fees may occur).

Nationals of Third Countries

If you do not have EU/EEA or Swiss nationality you are a so-called "national of a third country" and you will need an entry and residence title for entry to and residence in Austria.

Registration of your place of residence

Before entering Austria you should have a definite confirmation of admission of the institution at which you would like to study.

Within three days (working days) of entering Austria and also when moving house you have to register with the Registration Office by submitting your registration form (Meldezettel).

You have also to de-register at the end of your stay!

Registration and Enrollment:

After arrival in Linz students have to contact the international office (opend Wednesdays and Thursdays)!

Orientation day/s will take place in the beginning of each semester and exchange-students are expected to participate. Students will receive an invitation email time.

Admission to University:

- 1. International office will send you an email in time to start **pre-registration**.
- 2. After your arrival (after welcome meeting) you have to contact our students-departement (next to International office) for enrolment; you have to bring with you
 - ID code from pre-registration
 - Valid travelling document
 - registration of students-mobility, signed by international office
- 3. Students coming within the Erasmus Exchange Program or within an Bilateral Agreement are exempt from student fees but have to pay the student union fee (Euro 18,70 per term)
