

Please note that our deadline for receiving the application forms is **1st May 2015** for the 1st semester and full academic year and **1st October 2015** for the 2nd semester.

First, students have to read the information enclosed (in French and English). It's very important to be sure they understand the procedure.

Then, they have to go on the link: <http://www.univ-rennes2.fr/service-relations-internationales/etudiants-etrangeurs-candidater-programme-echange> , where they can find the application forms to fill in.

They are required to send us :

- The Application Form (to be signed also by their home coordinator)
 - The Accommodation Application Form, if they wish to book a room in a residence hall
 - A certificate of French language level, signed and stamped by the coordinator who selected them

- Courses should be chosen only in this catalogue.

We trust our partners for their selection of students. However, we wish to draw the attention of our partner institutions and of their students to the necessity of having basic skills in the French language to be able to attend courses (the great majority of which are in French) and take exams successfully. A B2 Level or at least a B1 level is highly recommended. In the latter case, students are strongly advised to attend a French language support class at the CIREFE on arrival (free of charge for 1 semester). Incoming exchange students are asked to send us a certificate stating their French language level, signed by the coordinator who selected them. If they have a proof of an official French language test, they should send us a copy of it.

Basic skills in the French language are necessary to ensure exam success and good integration on campus. Incoming students and their home university have the sole responsibility for registration at Rennes 2 university without those basic skills
